

## Associate in Arts to Bachelor in Arts in Business Administration

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Harper College (HC) and Governors State University (GovState) for the Business Administration degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Arts (AA) degree from HC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Business Administration from GovState.
