

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Harper College (Harper) and Governors State University (GovState) for the Criminal Justice degree program based on the current catalogs for both institutions. The student would receive an Associate in Arts (AA) degree from Harper and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Criminal Justice from GovState.
